Kathee Livengood Memorial Scholarship



The Kathee Livengood Memorial Scholarship has been established by the Grapevine Chamber Foundation, through its Kathee Livengood Scholarship Committee. Kathee was a successful Realtor; however, she managed to find time to belong to or support every civic organization and "cause" in Grapevine throughout her life. Over the years her passion for helping people helped raise thousands of dollars to assist the elderly and children through GRACE and the Women's Division; people injured and disabled through the Joey Wilkins Foundation; and everyone who was touched by Cancer by founding the Relay for Life event in Grapevine. She was the driving force behind these programs, but she was also actively involved in many other projects benefitting those in need.

To honor Kathee's passion for helping people, this scholarship has been established to assist women in Tarrant County to develop the skills needed to obtain employment or improve their earning potential. Examples are vocational schools, culinary institutes, beauty colleges, healthcare training facilities, trade schools, community colleges, or other institutes of higher learning.

Kathee Livengood Memorial Scholarship Criteria and Requirements

1. The scholarship is intended for women in Tarrant County who demonstrate a desire to improve their life and earning potential and need financial assistance to pursue further education and/or training to accomplish these goals.
2. Applicants must complete the attached application.
3. Applicants must submit an autobiography including information about her family life and financial need, and explain why she is deserving of the scholarship.
4. The scholarship amount is determined by the course of study and fees required (maximum of \$1,500) and will be paid directly to the educational entity. If paid in installments, recipient must provide documentation of successful course completion before funds will be disbursed.
5. Should an applicant enroll in Tarrant County College, a matching grant program is available. The applicant must meet certain requirements to be eligible.
6. Upon being awarded the scholarship, the recipient must provide written documentation from the school of her enrollment, fees required, where funds should be sent, and dates due.
7. If a recipient is unable to use all or any part of a scholarship, such funds may be awarded to another applicant. Applications will be reviewed by the Committee, and finalists may be contacted for an interview.
8. All information provided by applicants will be kept confidential by the Committee.
